
## **TEKS Resource System Updates for 2014-2015**



### What site updates can I expect for the upcoming school year?


Beginning in September, the TEKS Resource System will be providing access to specific system resources. Parents and others will soon have the ability to view all state adopted standards as well as TEKS Clarifications, Vertical Alignments, Enhanced TEKS Clarifications, TEKS Verifications, and curriculum components on Instructional Focus Documents. These resources can help support parents' understanding of the state-adopted standards as well as the TEKS Resource System.



#### What's happening with assessments?

Assessments are being delivered to district users through the **District Resources** tab-**Search All Content**. Districts will continue to have the ability to manage access to the unit assessment items.

Later this year, unit assessment items will be more dynamic, providing districts with even greater flexibility in managing and customizing assessment items. Further, districts will have the ability to turn on access to an assessment item bank in the **District Tools** tab that allows district users to build and customize their own assessments.



#### What does this all mean for how I find the TEKS Resource System resources I need?

District users will continue to login just as they always have. Now, unless utilizing the Quick Search, district users should navigate to the District Resources tab to locate all curriculum and assessment components, as well as all other resources that are managed by local districts. Beginning in September, when users click the District Resources tab, they will see several options. All resources available to and managed by districts, including all components and district-customized components, will be available by clicking **Search All Content**.
